





Plastic bags and overwrap

- * Non-paper gift wrap, foil wrap, cards or paper with glitter
- * Bags and boxes with foil liners
- * Paper towels, napkins and tissues
- * Rubber bands, ribbons, bows * Padded envelopes
- * Foil or plastic lined paper bags

NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Exclude batteries; medical sharps; bleach or aerosol containers with any contents remaining; compressed gas cylinders, for example used propane cylinders; containers for paint, motor oil, vehicle lubricants, or antifreeze; or containers for pesticides with the words DANGER, WARNING, or POISON, and precautionary octagon or diamond symbols with skull and cross bones.

* Packaging labeled biodegradable or compostable
